281. # DR. LAXMIKANT BAJPAYEE:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the current status of Government's plan to introduce HPV Vaccine in Universal Immunization Programme;
- (b) the status of HPV Vaccination programme in different states, if so, the details thereof, State-wise
- (c) the cost of imported and indigenous HPV vaccines available in the country;
- (d) the estimated rate of HPV Vaccination in the country in last five years, if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (e) the steps taken by Government to spread awareness about vaccination; and
- (f) whether Government has set any target for elimination of cervical cancer in the country, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)

- (a), (c) & (e) The Universal Immunization Programme (UIP) provides 11 vaccines against 12 Vaccine Preventable Diseases (VPDs). However, the HPV vaccine is not a part of the Universal Immunization Programme (UIP).
- (b) & (d) The HPV vaccine roll out is being implemented in the following states as on date:
 - **Sikkim:** The Government of Sikkim introduced the HPV vaccination program in 2018, targeting girls aged 9-14 years.
 - **Bihar:** The state introduced the HPV vaccination for girls aged 9 to 14 years under the Mukhyamantri Balika Cancer Immunization Scheme, from 6th October, 2024.
- (f) There is no specific target for the elimination of cervical cancer in the country.
