Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) the targets set and progress made under the LaQshya scheme, year-wise and State-wise, since 2020;
- (b) the targets set and progress made under the Janani Suraksha Yojna scheme, year-wise and State-wise, since 2020;
- (c) the budgetary allocation and percentage of utilisation under both schemes;
- (d) the number of ASHA workers engaged under the National Health Mission, State-wise and year-wise, since 2020; and
- (e) the number of maternal health-related hospital admissions authorised under AB-PMJAY since 2020, along with the amount reimbursed to private hospitals under the scheme, State-wise?

**ANSWER
THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH
AND FAMILY WELFARE
(SMT. ANUPRIYA PATEL)**

(a): The year-wise and State-wise progress since 2020, for LaQshya National certification of Labour Room and Maternity Operation Theaters, is placed at Annexure I and II respectively.

(b): The year-wise and State-wise progress since 2020, for Janani Suraksha Yojna (JSY), reported by States and UTs, is placed at Annexure III.

(c): The State-wise and year-wise budgetary approval and utilization under LaQshya and Janani Suraksha Yojna (JSY), since 2020 is placed at Annexure IV and V (data is as available FMRs reported by States and UTs and is provisional).

(d): The State-wise and year-wise number of ASHA workers engaged under the National Health Mission (NHM), since 2020 is placed at Annexure VI.

(e): Under Ayushman Bharat (AB) Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PM-JAY), more than 40.42 lakh maternal health related hospital admission worth Rs 3740.49 Crores have been authorized since FY 2020-21.

Out of this, more than 6.83 Lakh maternal health related hospital admission worth Rs 883.12 Crore have been authorized for empanelled private hospitals under the scheme since FY 2020-21.

State-wise number of maternal health-related hospital admissions along with the amount authorized since FY 2020-21 is enclosed in Annexure VII.
