#### **CERVICAL CANCER SCREENING**

#### 2847. DR. M. THAMBIDURAI:

#### Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) whether Government is aware that only less than 2 per cent of women in the country are screened for cervical cancer;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the data of women between the ages 15 and 50 years who have been screened for cervical cancer, State-wise; and

(d) the measures taken/proposed to be taken by Government to promote cervical cancer vaccination for girls/women?

#### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (c) Screening of common Non-Communicable Diseases(NCDs) including common cancers (viz. oral, breast and cervical) is an integral part of service delivery under Ayushman Arogya Mandirs. As per National NCD Portal as on 18th March, 2025 out of an eligible population of 25.16 crore women above the age of 30 years, 9.51 crore (37.7%) have been screened for cervical cancer. The data of women who have been screened for cervical cancer, State-wise, as per the National NCD Portal is as per Annexure-I.

(d) Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) vaccine for cervical cancer is not a part of the Universal Immunization Programme (UIP).
