(a) to (e): Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) - A scheme to bring about Blue Revolution through sustainable and responsible development of fisheries sector in India implemented by the Department of Fisheries, Government of India in all the States and Union Territories(UTs) inter-alia provides adoption of a cluster-based approach to enhance the competitiveness of the fisheries sector, facilitate economies of scale, generate higher incomes, and accelerate the growth and expansion of fisheries and aquaculture in an organized manner. This also aims to amplify outcomes and achieve integrated development within the sector. Thus, to continue and sustain the sectoral growth momentum, the Department of Fisheries, Government of India is further increasing its efforts on adoption of production and processing fisheries cluster based approach with end-to-end value chain in fisheries and aquaculture sector.

The Department of Fisheries, Government of India has notified an Organic Fisheries Cluster in Soreng District of Sikkim for development of organic fisheries and aquaculture in the State under PMMSY on 9th January, 2025 with focus on support for ecologically healthy fish farming systems.
