2980. SHRI SANDEEP KUMAR PATHAK:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the list of toll tax collected on NH and other Central Government owned expressways during the last three financial years and payment done to the companies running the toll plazas, yearwise and State-wise/UT-wise;
- (b) the amount of investment of various companies on construction of NH and amount of the loan/liability on NHAI as on date;
- (c) the list of toll plazas that have been abolished/removed during the last three years, Statewise/UT-wise;
- (d) the average per km rate of toll tax to be paid for various categories of vehicles, State-wise/UT-wise; and
- (e) the list of funds released and utilised to NHAI during the last three years, year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) The details of user fee collected on National Highways and Expressways during last three financial years are at Annexure A.

Further, during bidding process of a user fee plaza, user fee collecting agency has to quote remittance that will be paid by fee collecting agency to National Highways Authority of India (NHAI). This remittance is derived by fee collecting agency after estimating total collection from user fee plaza and adjusting administrative/operation charges for running of user fee plaza and contractor's profit. Hence, for operation and other expenses incurred on user fee plaza, no payment is done to user fee collecting agencies as same is already accounted for in their bid.

- (b) The amount of private investment of various companies on construction of National Highways since Financial Year 2004-05 up to 28.02.2025 is Rs.3,41,509.46 crore. The total outstanding debt of NHAI as on 28.02.2025 is Rs. 2,55,254 crore.
- (c) The details of user fee plazas that have been abolished /removed during last three years are at Annexure B.

(d) The base rates for the calculation of user fee rates are uniform across the National Highways. The base rates for various categories of vehicles for use of a section of national highway of four or more lanes for the financial year 2024-25 are as under:
