3022 DR. PARMAR JASHVANTSINH SALAMSINH:

Will the Minister of *Tribal Affairs* be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated by the Ministry for the scheme;
- (b) the number of tribal villages to be developed under the scheme;
- (c) whether steps have been taken to address health infrastructure in tribal villages; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**(a) to (d):** Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan comprises of 25 interventions implemented by 17 line Ministries and aims to saturate infrastructural gaps in 63,843 villages, improve access to health, education, Anganwadi facilities and providing livelihood opportunities in 549 districts and 2,911 blocks in 30 States/UTs in 5 years. The Abhiyan has total budgetary outlay of Rs.79,156 Cr (Central share: ₹56,333 Cr and State share: ₹22,823 Cr). Each concerned Ministry has been allocated budget and targets under Abhiyan and responsible for implementing the intervention assigned to it. The Abhiyan aims at Saturation through convergence and outreach. The details of various interventions along with targets and financial allocations, Ministry-wise, thereof under the Abhiyan are at **Annexure-I**. The State/UT-wise coverage of villages under this Abhiyan is at **Annexure-II**. Under Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare has sanctioned 36 MMUs.
