CHEAP ELECTRICITY THROUGH PMSGMBY

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the PM Surya Ghar Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSGMBY) has been launched by Government to provide electricity at cheap rate across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the number of houses currently targeted to be benefited under the said scheme and the achievements made so far, State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) to (c) The PM Surya Ghar: Muft Bijli Yojana (PMSG: MBY) has been launched with an aim to increase the share of solar rooftop capacity in the country and empower residential households to generate their own electricity. The scheme targets to achieve rooftop solar installations in 1 crore households in residential sector by FY 2026-27 with an outlay of Rs 75,021 crore. These household will be able to generate most of their electricity need over next 25 years, which is the expected life of solar modules.

The state/UT-wise number of households benefitted through installation of rooftop solar plants under the scheme, as on 27.01.2025, are given at **Annexure.**
