Annexure II

Government of India has offered new loans, under the Lines of Credit (LOCs) and Concessional Financing Scheme (CFS), through a lending bank to 6 partner countries during January 2022 - January 2025. The total amount of loans (under LOCs and CFS) offered to these partner countries during the above-mentioned period stands at over USD 3.73 billion. This excludes disbursements for ongoing projects under earlier LOCs.

Government of India receives external assistance from Multilateral and Bilateral Sources. Multilateral sources include World Bank Group [International Bank For Reconstruction And Development (IBRD) & International Development Association (IDA)], Asian Development Bank (ADB), European Investment Bank (EIB), New development Bank (NDB), Asia Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD) and Global Fund Organization. Bilateral sources include assistance from Japan, Germany, Russian Federation, France and South Korea.
