(a) The cargo volumes handled by Indian Ports in FY 2024 and trend over the last three years is as under:-

(b) The government has taken various steps to streamline logistics for export-oriented industries such as the construction of new berths, terminals and parking plazas, mechanization/ modernization/ optimization of existing berths and terminals, streamlining of processes through digitalization, expansion of hinterland connectivity through rail and road, etc.
