SPORTS COMPLEX IN MAYURBHANJ DISTRICT OF ODISHA

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state :-

- (a) whether Government has received any proposal or planning to construct the sports complex in Mayurbhanj district of Odisha;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, if not, whether Government will consider the same;
- (c) the details of funds released to State of Odisha under the Khelo India scheme for promotion of sports activities in the State during the last three years; and
- (d) the details of fund generated through CSR fund to encourage the sportsmen/ athlete/ players during last three years, district-wise?

(a) and (b) Yes, Sir. One project, namely, “Construction of Sports Complex at Rairangpur, District Mayurbhanj, Odisha”, has been sanctioned under the Khelo India Scheme.
