SURVEY OF FARMERS LIVING BELOW POVERTY LINE

3204. SHRI C. VE. SHANMUGAM:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted any survey to assess the number of farmers including marginal farmers, living below the poverty line;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether Government has formulated any welfare scheme for such farmers;
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the number of farmers benefitted from such welfare schemes?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE (SHRI RAMNATH THAKUR)

- (a) & (b): No, the government has not conducted any such survey to assess the number of farmers including marginal farmers, living below the poverty line. Therefore, no details are available. However, as per the latest Agriculture Census, 2015-16, conducted by Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, the number of operational holdings in marginal size group State/UT-wise is given at **Annexure**.
- (c) to (e): Agriculture is a State subject and Government of India supports the efforts of States through appropriate policy measures, budgetary allocation and various schemes/ programmes. The various schemes/ programmes of the Government of India are meant for the welfare of farmers including marginal farmers by increasing production, remunerative returns and income support to farmers. The Major schemes/programmes initiated by DA&FW to enhance overall income of farmers and remunerative returns in the agriculture sector are as under:

Further, the major welfare schemes/programmes under which the number of farmer benefited are as follows:

- 1. Under the PM-KISAN scheme, the Government has disbursed over Rs. 3.68 Lakh Cr in 19 installments since inception year, 2019. 19th Installment of PM-KISAN scheme was released on 24th February, 2025 and more than 9.8 crore farmers received the benefits amounting to over Rs. 22,000 crore.
- 2. Further, under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) as on 28.02.2025, against the farmer's premium of Rs.32,476 crore, claims of Rs.1,73,938 crore have been paid to 1,979 lakh farmer applications from inception year, 2016-17 upto the year, 2023-24.
