IMPLEMENTATION OF PMGSY-IV

3332 SHRI MADAN RATHORE:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of roads constructed under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) scheme from 2022 till February 2025;
- (b) the funds allocated for the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana-IV (PMGSY-IV); and
- (c) the number of unconnected habitations to be covered under PMGSY-IV?

ANSWER

(SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): A total of 69,666.09 km of road length has been constructed under various ongoing interventions/verticals of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojna (PMGSY) across the country from 2022 to February 2025.

(b) & (c): The Government has approved phase IV of PMGSY on 11th September 2024 to provide all-weather road connectivity to 25,000 unconnected habitations of population size 500+ in plains, 250+ in NE & Hill States/UTs, special category areas (Tribal Schedule V, Aspirational Districts/Blocks, Desert areas) and 100+ in LWE affected areas (notified by MHA in 9 States) , as per Census 2011. A total of 62,500 km of road length is proposed to be constructed at a cost of ₹ 70,125 crore during the period from 2024-25 to 2028-29.

Under PMGSY-IV, States/UTs are identifying eligible habitations as per the programme guidelines. The Central Government is working closely with the States to facilitate submission of proposals under the programme.
