- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (C) the proactive steps taken by Government to conduct extensive excavations at potential sites like Keezhadi, Kodumanal, Mayiladumparai in Tamil Nadu to bring out remnants of Archaic Tamil Civilization?

- (a) and (b) Archaeological evidence in Tamil Nadu have been brought to light through various excavations and explorations conducted by the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) and State Department of Archaeology, Government of Tamil Nadu. The details of excavations conducted during the last 5 years is enclosed at Annexure.
- (c) ASI had initiated excavation at Keezhadi from 2014 to 2016 which was continued by the State Archaeology Department, Government of Tamil Nadu from 2020 till date. State Archaeology Department, Government of Tamil Nadu had also conducted excavation at Kodumanal in 2020 and Mayiladumparai in 2020 and 2021.
