#### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE UNDER NATIONAL BIO ENERGY PROGRAMME

### 3501.SHRI ADITYA PRASAD

Will the Minister of **NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has notified any guidelines for the development of bio-energy projects in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the amount of financial assistance provided for the said purpose and whether Government has made separate provisions for providing financial assistance to various States including the State of Jharkhand in respect of bio-energy projects, if so, the details of the financial assistance, State-wise?

#### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER

#### (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

(a)&(b) Yes. The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy has notified National Bioenergy Programme (NBP) along with guidelines on 02.11.2022, to support the installation of Bioenergy Projects in the country for the period 2021-22 to 2025-26. The NBP has a budget outlay of Rs. 858 Crore, under Phase-1 of the Programme. The National Bioenergy Programme has a provision to provide Central Financial Assistance (CFA) for setting up of Bioenergy projects in the country under the following components:

- (i) Waste to Energy Programme: Programme on Energy from Urban, Industrial and Agricultural Wastes /Residues
- (ii) **Biomass Programme:** Scheme to Support Manufacturing of Briquettes & Pellets and Promotion of Biomass (non-bagasse) based cogeneration in Industries)
- (iii) Biogas Programme: Programme to support setting up of small (1 m<sup>3</sup> to 25 m<sup>3</sup> biogas per day) and medium size Biogas plants (above 25 m<sup>3</sup> to 2500 m<sup>3</sup> biogas generation per day).

The component wise Central Financial Assistance being provided under the NBP is given in **Annexure-I.** 

(c) The details of State wise financial assistance provided by MNRE for setting up of bioenergy projects under the National Bioenergy Programme is given in **Annexure-II.** For installing small biogas plants, annual targets are given to all states, including the State of Jharkhand.
