3531 **Dr. John Brittas:**

Will the Minister of *Education* be pleased to state:

- (a) the annual budget for Samagra Shiksha scheme for the last five years;
- (b) actual funds released to the States against the allocated targets thereof;
- (c) amounts yet to be released/unpaid to various States during last five financial years;
- (d) State-wise and year-wise details thereof;
- (e) whether Government agree to bring Government aided schools in Kerala also under the ambit of Samagra Shiksha for providing funds to these aided schools as well considering the fact that these schools are viewed as public schools in Kerala and salaries to teachers are being disbursed from State exchequer; and
- (f) if not, reasons therefor?

(a) : The Budget under Samagra Shiksha for the last five years is given below:

(c) & (d): Under Samagra Shiksha, funds are released to the States/UTs based on the pace of expenditure, receipt of commensurate state share, audited accounts, statement on outstanding advances, up-to date expenditure statement, audited utilization certificate of previous year and furnishing of requisite information as prescribed by Ministry of Finance and the Manual on Financial Management & Procurement of the scheme. The allocation of central share to States/UTs under Samagra Shiksha are made as per the Budget Estimates (BE) and Revised Estimates (RE) provided by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance. State-wise details of the funds allocated and Central Share released during 2024-25 is at **Annexure**.

(e) & (f): Under the Samagra Shiksha scheme provisions are provided for aided schools under some interventions such as Textbooks, Holistic Report Card, Provision for Children with Special Needs. The financial assistance is provided to States and UTs for implementation of these interventions as per the annual plans submitted by the States and UTs in their respective Annual Work Plan and Budget (AWP&B). These plans are then appraised and approved/estimated by Project Approval Board (PAB) meeting held under the Chairpersonship of Secretary, School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education in consultation with the States and UTs as per the programmatic and financial norms of the scheme.
