Will the Minister of PANCHAYATI RAJ be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government is aware of the gaps in training and capacity-building programmes provided to elected representatives of Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRI) and, if so, the specific challenges identified in this regard;
- (b) the steps taken by Government to address these gaps and improve the effectiveness of capacity-building initiatives, including details of any new proposals or strategies planned for the same; and
- (c) the total number of elected PRI representatives who have been trained under various schemes from 2021 onwards, along with the details of region-specific training programmes conducted?

(a) to (c) Ministry is implementing Revamped Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan (RGSA) w.e.f. financial year 2022-23 in States/ UTs with main objective of capacitating Panchayati Raj institutions (PRIs) through imparting training to the Elected Representatives (ERs), functionaries and other stakeholders to develop their governance capabilities for leadership roles to enable the Panchayats to function effectively.

Under the scheme, Ministry provides support for capacity building and training of elected representatives, functionaries and other stakeholders of Panchayats in different categories viz. basic orientation and refresher training, thematic training, specialized training, panchayat development plan training, etc. Apart from different training, Ministry also supports for exposure visits, development of training modules and materials, etc. In addition, anew initiative has been taken for capacity building and training of elected representatives and functionaries of Panchayats through institutes of excellence viz. IIMs/IITs under Leadership/Management Development Program (MDP).

Further, capacity building and training of elected representatives and functionaries were taken on various aspects such as preparation of thematic development plan, financial

management, use of Information Communication Technology (ICT) in rural governance and service delivery, specialized training, etc. These trainings have enhanced governance at grassroots level. The elected representatives and functionaries are using GramSwaraj application developed under e-Panchayat Mission Model Project (MMP), which facilitated digital planning, accounting, monitoring, and online payments. Under the scheme, no gaps have been identified by the Ministry in respect of Capacity Building & Training of Elected Representatives.

Details of Elected Representatives trained under Rashtriya Gram Swaraj Abhiyan, since 2022-23 as reported by States/ UTs on Training Management Portal (TMP), and for the year 2021-22 total participants trained including Elected Representatives is attached at **Annexure-I**.
