# STEPS TO ENHANCE ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE

3625 SHRI JAGGESH: SMT. SUNETRA AJIT PAWAR:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Highway construction has been a major focus under Government and the pace of highway construction has significantly increased during last five years;
- (b) if so, the total length of National Highways (NHs) constructed by Government during last five years, State-wise and year-wise;
- (c) the total length of National High-Speed Corridors constructed during last five years;
- (d) the total length of 4-lane and above National Highways (excluding High Speed Corridors) constructed during last five years, State-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by Government to enhance road infrastructure, details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

### (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) Yes sir. The average pace of construction of National Highways (NHs) during the last five years from 2019-20 to 2023-24, was about 31 km per day, as compared to about 22 km per day during the previous five-year period from 2014-15 to 2018-19.
- (b) The State/UT wise and year wise details of length of NHs constructed during the last five years is at Annexure-I.
- (c) The Government in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has constructed total length of about 3,660 km High-Speed Corridors during the last five years.
- (d) The State/ UT wise details of the length of four lanes or higher configuration of NHs (excluding High-Speed Corridors), constructed during the last five years is at Annexure-II.
- (e) The Government has taken several steps to enhance road infrastructure in the NH sector like expanding the NH network, promoting integrated planning and alignment optimization through the PM GatiShakti National Master Plan portal, identifying and taking up important corridors for development, increasing budgetary allocation for projects, encouraging private investment through PPP model, adopting innovative financing methods like InvIT, preparing a shelf of DPRs in advance, streamlining the land acquisition process through Bhoomi Rashi portal, streamlining the process of environment/forest/wildlife clearances through

PARIVESH portal, promoting the domestic contractor ecosystem, revamping the dispute resolution mechanism, leveraging private sector expertise in project supervision, deploying online project monitoring system, using GIS/IT/Mobile App/Drone Technology for road condition monitoring and intervention, encouraging the use of new technology, promoting knowledge acquisition/sharing and capacity building, etc.
