INTRODUCTION OF ANNUAL AND LIFETIME TOLL PASSES

3637. SHRI BABUBHAI JESANGBHAI DESAI: DR. MEDHA VISHRAM KULKARNI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the introduction of annual and lifetime toll passes is expected to reduce congestion at toll plazas and improve traffic flow;

(b) the impact of these passes on overall toll revenue, considering private cars contribute around 20-26 per cent of toll collections despite forming 60 per cent of highway traffic; and

(c) whether Government has conducted any financial assessment on the long-term implications of such toll passes on highway maintenance and infrastructure development?
