Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:-

- (a) the total number of fatalities in sanitation work during the last five years, State-wise and district-wise details in the State of Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the funds sanctioned and released under National Action for Mechanised Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE) since its inception, State-wise details thereof;
- (c) the total number of persons trained in mechanised sanitation since its inception, State-wise and district-wise details in the State of Andhra Pradesh; and
- (d) the total number of personal protective equipment kits distributed, State-wise and district-wise details in the State of Andhra Pradesh?

ANSWER

(a) As per information provided by National Commission for Safai Karamcharis (NCSK), 301 persons have lost their lives during last five years due to hazardous cleaning of sewer and septic tanks. Year-wise and State/UT-wise details are at **Annexure-I.**

District—wise details of deaths which have occurred due to hazardous cleaning of sewer and septic tanks in Andhra Pradesh is as under:-

- i.Tirupati (3 deaths). ii.Krishna (2 deaths).
- (b) National Action for Mechanised Sanitation Ecosystem" (NAMASTE) scheme is a Central Sector Scheme and there is no provision for State-wise allocation of funds.

- (c) Capacity Building of Sewer and Septic Tank Workers (SSWs) is covered through (i) workshops on prevention of hazardous cleaning of sewers and (ii) occupational training as Junior Technician-Mechanized Sewer Cleaning and Desludging Operator. Under NAMASTE scheme training is yet to commence.
