- (b) the details of the total amount allocated, spent and progress made with reference to above, year-wise and cultural site-wise for Tamil Nadu from 2020 till date; and
- (c) whether Government has implemented any digital or technological initiatives, such as virtual tours or augmented reality experiences, to enhance the accessibility and awareness of cultural sites in Tamil Nadu, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) There are 413 centrally protected monuments/archaeological sites under the jurisdiction of
- & Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) in the State of Tamil Nadu. The conservation of these
- (b) monuments/ archaeological sites is taken up as per the need and availability of resources. The details of amount allocated and expenditure incurred for conservation, maintenance and development of protected monuments/archaeological sites in the State of Tamil Nadu is as under:
