DILAPIDATED CONDITION OF BEEDI HOSPITAL AT TARAPUR

- (a) whether it is a fact that Tarapur Beedi Hospital in Murshidabad has been plagued by lack of funds, shortage of doctors and technicians and basic amenities; and**
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor?**

(a) & (b): The Central Hospital, Tarapur, Murshidabad is a 65 bedded hospital providing both Outpatient Department (OPD) and Inpatient Department (IPD) treatments including emergency services to Beedi workers and their dependents. At present there are 05 Medical Officers, 05 Staff Nurses, 01 Technician, 02 Pharmacists and other supporting Staff posted at the Hospital. As regards vacant posts, the recruitment of Doctors, Nursing and Paramedical Staff is a continuous process. The vacancies in various cadres of Doctors, Nursing and Paramedical Staff are filled on contractual basis till regular appointments are made. The funds are provided as per budgetary allocations.
