(a) to (f): The management of waste at all places including tourist places are addressed by State Government and local bodies. Ministry of Tourism and Department of Drinking water and Sanitation, Ministry of Jal Shakti has taken various initiatives to create awareness.

Ministry of Tourism also undertakes the cleanliness drive including solid waste management issues and awareness programme activities under Swachhta Hi Seva, Swachhta Action Plan through their Regional Offices, Educational Institutes like Indian Institute of Tourism and Travel Management (IITTM), Central Institute of Hotel Management, State Institute of Hotel Management and Food Craft Institute across the country.
