**Auction of coal blocks**

**38 Shri Saket Gokhale:**

Will the Minister of *COAL* be pleased to state:

- (a) the results of the 10th round of auction of coal blocks by the Ministry and whether all 67 blocks have been auctioned off;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of successful bidders in the 10th round of auctions; and
- (d) the revenue received by Government through the 10th round of auctions?

**(a) and (b)** Out of the 67 coal mines offered under the 10th round of auctions, 9 have been successfully auctioned. Additionally, 1 coal mine had received one bid under second attempt of auctions and is being considered for allocation. Other 57 coal mines could not be auctioned due to unavailability of sufficient number of bids.

**(c)** The list of successful bidders of 9 coal mines in the 10th Tranche of commercial coal auction is as below:
