Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government has conducted any survey for a new high-speed (bullet train) rail corridor from Ahmedabad to Delhi, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the names of all the proposed stations on the said corridor as per the survey and the names of the cities of Rajasthan through which it will pass; and
- (c) the proposed allocation of funds for the said corridor project and the timeline fixed for its completion?

(a) to (c): Presently, Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail (MAHSR) Project (508 Kms) is the only sanctioned project of High Speed Rail in India under execution with technical and financial assistance from Government of Japan.

HSR project are highly capital intensive and any decision for taking up new project is based on many factors such as technical feasibility, financial & economic viability, traffic demand and availability of funds & financing options etc. Presently, railways is focused on execution of the first high speed rail project.
