AMRIT SAROVAR PROJECT IN KARNATAKA

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives of Mission Amrit Sarovar;
- (b) the details of Amrit Sarovars (Ponds) identified under Amrit Sarovar Mission in the State of Karnataka, district-wise; and
- (c) the status of developing/rejuvenation of Amrit Sarovars identified from Karnataka?

(a)to (c): Mission Amrit Sarovar was launched in April 2022 with the ambitious goal of constructing or rejuvenating 75 Amrit Sarovars (ponds) in each district, totaling 50,000 across the country. This initiative has made significant progress in addressing the critical issue of water scarcity and has contributed in enhancing surface and groundwater availability across various regions. These Sarovars have not only addressed immediate water needs but also established sustainable water sources, symbolizing Government's commitment to long-term environmental sustainability and community well-being. As on 31st March 2025, over 68,000 Sarovars have been completed.

Phase II of Mission Amrit Sarovar envisaged to continue with a renewed focus on ensuring water availability, with community participation (Jan Bhagidaari) at its core, and aims to strengthen climate resilience, foster ecological balance, and deliver lasting benefits for future generations.

Under the Mission Amrit Sarovar, a total of 4,056 Amrit Sarovar works were completed in Karnataka State. District-wise details of Amrit Sarovar completed in Karnataka as on 31.03.2025 are given at **Annexure**.
