STATUS OF RAILWAY COACH MANUFACTURING UNIT AT KAZIPET

602 SHRI RAVI CHANDRA VADDIRAJU:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry can provide details on the current status of the railway coach manufacturing unit at Kazipet;
- (b) the reasons for the delay in its implementation despite the foundation stone being laid in July 2023; and
- (c) the steps taken to expedite the project and the timeline for its completion, particularly in light of the commitments made under the Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act, 2014?

(a) to (c) Indian Railways has planned to develop a Railway Manufacturing Unit at Kazipet, Telangana at a cost of Rs. 521.36 Crs which will be capable of manufacturing and maintaining a variety of modern Rolling Stocks. Till December, 2024 expenditure amounting to Rs. 251.09 Crs has already been made on this work. Further adequate funds have been allocated for this work in 2024-25.
