- (a) whether Government has planned to expedite the construction of Nanded Latur , Udgir Bodhan Degloor and Bodhan Biloli Mudkhed Tajband Latur lines; and
- (b) the timeline by when these three routes are planned to be operational, the details thereof?

(a) and (b): Surveys of new lines Nanded-Latur Road (104 km) and Bodhan - Latur Road (135 km) have been sanctioned.

As regards Udgir-Bodhan-Degloor Line, both Udgir and Bodhan are connected with the railway network and Udgir – Degloor - Bodhan route is near to new line survey taken up of Bodhan-Latur Road.

Sanctioning of Railway projects is a continuous and dynamic process of Indian Railway. Railway Infrastructure Projects are taken up on the basis of remunerativeness, last mile connectivity, missing links and alternate routes, augmentation of congested/saturated lines socio-economic considerations etc. depending upon liabilities of ongoing projects, overall availability of funds and competing demands.

Sanctioning of project requires consultation with various stake-holders including State Governments and necessary approvals viz. appraisal of NITI Aayog, Ministry of Finance etc. As sanctioning of projects is a continuous and dynamic process, exact timelines cannot be fixed.
