EMPLOYMENT GUARANTEE SCHEME IN URBAN AREAS

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Government will consider introducing an employment guarantee scheme for urban areas:
- (b) if so, the details and the timeline for its implementation; and
- (c) whether Government has undertaken any feasibility studies or consultations for such a scheme, and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI TOKHAN SAHU)

(a) to (c): In order to enhance livelihood opportunities in the urban settings, Ministry of Housing & Urban Affairs (MoHUA) supplements the effort of States/UTs by providing assistance under various programmes like the "Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM)" which was implemented from February 2016 to 30th September, 2024. The mission aimed to reduce poverty and vulnerability of the urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment, resulting in an appreciable improvement in their livelihoods on a sustainable basis through its different components viz. Social Mobilisation and Institution Development (SM&ID), Employment through Skill Training & Placement (ESTP), Self Employment Programme (SEP). Currently, there is no proposal to introduce Urban Employment Guarantee Scheme for urban areas.
