(a) & (b) Building on the remarkable success of its previous two editions, India Energy Week 2025 (IEW'25), the flagship energy event of Government of India, is being held under the patronage of the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, organised by Federation of Indian Petroleum Industry (FIPI), from 11th to 14th February 2025 at the Yashobhoomi Convention Centre, New Delhi.

(c) For international participants, especially foreign ministers and Chief Executive Officers (CEOs), the event offers opportunities to strengthen energy partnerships, explore investments and gain insights into India's evolving energy policies and transition roadmap.

With India being a fast-growing energy market, CEOs can identify business expansion opportunities in over all value chain of hydrocarbon sector including renewable energy, hydrogen, biofuels etc. while networking with key stakeholders. The event also highlights cutting-edge technologies, enabling knowledge exchange and showcasing innovations in clean energy and sustainability.
