- (a) the objectives of the National Data and Analytics Platform (NDAP) in terms of enhancing data accessibility for various stakeholders;
- (b) the manner in which NDAP ensures that the datasets hosted on the platform are standardized and interoperable across different sectors; and
- (c) the types of datasets currently available on NDAP and the manner in which they are selected for inclusion?

(a) to (c): The National Data and Analytics Platform (NDAP) was launched in May 2022 by NITI Aayog towards streamlining dissemination of published government data through an intuitive, user-friendly platform. Data sets hosted on NDAP are standardized using Local Government Directory (LGD) codes allowing for seamless cross-sectoral analysis. Presently, the data universe identified for NDAP includes 7460 datasets, out of which for each quarter specific datasets are uploaded based on user feedback, relevance, etc.
