- (b) whether Government has established any collaboration with international organizations for validating Ayurvedic drugs;
- (c) if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the financial allocation made for such research in the current fiscal year?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

- (a) The total number of clinical trials conducted for ayurvedic formulations by various Council / Institutes under the Ministry of Ayush viz. Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), National Institute of Ayurveda (NIA), All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA) and Institute of Teaching and Research in Ayurveda (ITRA) during the last three years are given in **Annexure-I**.
- (b)&(c) The various Council / Institutes under the Ministry of Ayush viz. CCRAS, NIA and AIIA have established collaboration with international organisations for validating Ayurvedic drugs as per details given in **Annexure-II**.

- (d) The financial allocation made for research activities including research on clinical trials and validating Ayurvedic drugs in the current fiscal year by various Council / Institutes viz. CCRAS, NIA, AIIA and ITRA is as under:-
  - 1. CCRAS Rs.48.51 Crore
  - 2. NIA Rs. 0.28 Crore
  - 3. AIIA Rs. 2.60 Crore
  - 4. ITRA Rs.85.55 Crore
