Opening of Ayurvedic hospitals in Jharkhand

Will the Minister of **Ayush** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is any scheme being run/initiative being taken to open Ayurvedic hospitals in the State of Jharkhand; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYUSH (SHRI PRATAPRAO JADHAV)

(a) to (b) Public Health being a State subject, opening of Ayurvedic hospitals in Jharkhand comes under the purview of respective State Government. However, under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National Ayush Mission (NAM), there is a provision of financial assistance for setting up of 50 /30 /10 bedded integrated Ayush hospitals. Accordingly, the State Government may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposals through State Annual Action Plans (SAAP) as per the provisions of NAM guidelines. Under NAM, as per the proposals received from the State Government of Jharkhand through SAAPs, Ministry of Ayush has approved seven units of integrated Ayush Hospitals at Ranchi, Gumla, Bokaro, Deoghar, Palamu, Dumka, East Singhbum.
