STATUS OF ONE NATION, ONE RATION CARD SCHEME IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution be pleased to state:

(a) the current status of implementation of the One Nation, One Ration Card (ONORC) scheme in Odisha;

(b) the number of inter-State and intra-State transactions completed under the scheme in Odisha;

(c) the challenges faced in implementing ONORC in the State; and

(d) the steps being taken to address these challenges and ensure seamless portability of ration cards?

(a) & (b): The nationwide portability of ration cards, popularly known as One Nation One Ration Card (ONORC) has been implemented in all 36 States/UTs, including State of Odisha, covering almost 100% PMGKAY beneficiaries. Since its inception, around 164 crore portability transactions have been recorded Pan India under the ONORC. The details of inter-State and intra-State transactions in Odisha State is as under:-

(c) & (d): The portability of ration cards under ONORC is seamlessly implemented in the State. ONORC is being facilitated through robust IT system, there is no such challenge in the implementation.
