- (c) the role of milk producer unions and Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) therein?

(a) to (c): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (C) IN RESPECT OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 115 FOR REPLY ON 30TH JULY, 2025 ASKED BY SMT. DARSHANA SINGH REGARDING INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF COOPERATIVES.

(a): The Ministry of Cooperation is commemorating the United Nations–International Year of Cooperatives (IYC) 2025 with the theme “*Cooperatives Build a Better World*”, as officially launched by the Hon’ble Prime Minister in 2024 at the ICA Global Cooperative Conference. A wide range of activities are being organized throughout the year with the objective of increasing transparency & accountability, improving operational efficiency, promoting cooperation among cooperatives, engagement of youth and women in cooperatives and strengthening cooperative governance through Model Bye-laws. These include organization of various workshops, tree plantation drives, training programs, capacity-building sessions, exhibitions, sports events, walkathons, and awareness campaigns. These activities are being conducted at various stages including the level of individual cooperative societies, district level, state level and national level. The celebrations are being implemented in a phased and coordinated manner under the IYC Annual Action Plan which was released by the Ministry in January 2025.

On the request of Ministry of Cooperation, various other Central Ministries and Departments have also started using the IYC 2025 logo on their official communications, websites, and public interfaces.

(b): States and Union Territories are playing a vital and active role in the planning and execution of IYC 2025 activities. They have developed and operationalized their respective action plans and undertaken various cooperative activities in coordination with the Ministry. These include cooperative exhibitions, seminars, state-level conferences, district-level workshops, awareness campaigns, and programmes for youth and women. States have also participated actively in national campaigns such as “*Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam*” and “*Swachhta me Sahkar*”, showcasing their ownership and commitment at the grassroots level.

The Ministry of Cooperation is also regularly conducting review meetings with stakeholders including State Governments to monitor the implementation of IYC activities and ensure alignment with the overall objectives of the campaign. The details of the major activities undertaken and reported by States/UTs under the celebration of IYC till June, 2025 are provided at Annexure-A.

(c) Various stakeholders of the Ministry of Cooperation, including milk producer unions and Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs), have been actively participating in the International Year of Cooperatives 2025. Alongside the State Governments, the respective State Dairy Federations are also playing a crucial role in implementation and outreach.

The National Cooperative Dairy Federation of India (NCDFI) has undertaken several initiatives under IYC–2025, such as capacity-building of milk societies, promotion of digital interfaces for service delivery, and encouraging environmental awareness among dairy farmers. One of the largest dairy cooperatives in the country, AMUL, has also been prominently involved in the celebrations. It has carried the IYC logo on milk packets across India and organised multiple events in collaboration with the Ministry. AMUL launched the IYC-2025 with a widely circulated Amul Topical featuring the Amul Girl, reaching crores of people across print and digital platforms in 15 languages. Over 1 crore citizens viewed the iconic farmer-funded film *Manthan*, screened nationwide in cinemas, on Doordarshan and Zee Cinema, and internationally at the Academy Museum in Los Angeles. In March 2025, 300 lakh Amul milk pouches per day carried the IYC logo, furthering awareness. IYC was also promoted at Gulf Food 2025, engaging over 100,000 global professionals.

A major national-level event was organised on **6th July 2025** at the NDDB Campus in Anand, Gujarat, with participation from leading milk producer unions, State Dairy Federations, and other cooperative stakeholders from across the country. On this occasion, the Hon'ble Union Home and Cooperation Minister launched key initiatives including new Sardar Patel Cooperative Dairy Federation (SPCDF) Limited to unify village-level dairy cooperatives across India under a multi-state model. Hon'ble Minister also inaugurated major Amul infrastructure expansion projects, including Mozzarella Cheese Plant, a modern UHT unit, an ultra-modern cheese warehouse, and Amul Chocolate Plant. NCDFI's new state-of-the-art Office Complex was also inaugurated on 06th July, 2025. On the occasion of Diamond Jubilee Year of NDDB, Hon'ble Minister inaugurated new office complex and Ready-to-Use Culture (RUC) Plant at Anand, Gujarat on 06th July 2025, marking a historic milestone in the Indian dairy sector's journey towards Aatmanirbhar Bharat.

The active engagement of milk cooperatives and FPOs in such events has helped to amplify the message of cooperation, enhance farmer participation, and promote the role of grassroots-level institutions in driving inclusive and sustainable development under the IYC–2025 framework.
