#### VACANCIES AND ENCROACHMENT ISSUES UNDER ASI RAIGANJ CIRCLE

#### \*131. SHRI SAMIK BHATTACHARYA

Will the Minister of CULTURE be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that there is 40 per cent vacancy in sanctioned posts at ASI Raiganj Circle and if so, the steps being taken to fill these vacancies;
- b) total number of monuments under the protection of ASI Raiganj, along with the number of those affected by encroachments and unauthorized constructions, including their names and locations;
- c) whether any notices or legal actions have been initiated against encroachers at ASI protected monuments in the Raiganj Circle and if so, the status of these actions; and
- d) measures Government is taking to protect heritage sites under ASI Raiganj from further encroachments and ensure their proper conservation?

#### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF CULTURE AND TOURISM (SHRI GAJENDRA SINGH SHEKHAWAT)

(a) to (d) A Statement is laid on the table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) TO (d) OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 131 FOR 31.7.2025 RAISED BY SHRI SAMIK BHATTACHARYA, HON'BLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT REGARDING VACANCIES AND ENCROACHMENT ISSUES UNDER ASI RAIGANJ CIRCLE.

(a) :Yes Sir. At present, there are approximately 40% vacancies at Raiganj Circle of Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). The vacancy position at Raiganj Circle, ASI is as under: -

Out of the 56 vacancies in Raiganj Circle, 33 vacancies pertain to Multi-Tasking Staff (MTS). 08 casual labours who have been granted  $1/30^{th}$  status are currently working against the MTS vacancies while appointment orders for 05 more newly recruited MTSs have been issued in July, 2025.

Filling up of vacancies is an ongoing process and the vacancies in ASI are filled up by Promotion, Deputation and Direct Recruitment. The Departmental Promotion Committee (DPC) meetings for filling up the vacant posts through Promotion are held at regular intervals, subject to fulfilling of eligibility criteria by officials in the feeder grades. The vacancies to be filled up by Deputation are advertised as per laid down procedure. The vacancies falling under Direct Recruitment (DR) quota are promptly reported to the Recruitment agencies i.e., UPSC and SSC.

The Staff Selection Commission has recently declared the results for 85 Junior Secretariat Assistants and 155 Conservation Assistants which will further bring down the vacancies.

- (b): There are 52 protected monuments and protected areas (sites) under care and maintenance of Raiganj Circle of the Archaeological Survey of India. Unauthorized construction is reported at 28 monuments and encroachment is reported at 5 monuments. The details of these protected monuments and protected areas (sites) in Raiganj circle are enclosed at **Annexure I.**
- (c): The ASI has taken action on noticing any such activities on or around the protected monuments by way of issuing Stop Notices to defaulters and writing to State/local authorities for taking appropriate action including filing police complaints.
- (d): In order to contain the encroachments and remove them, the Superintending Archaeologist is authorised to issue show cause notices and lodge police complaints, followed by a communication to the District Collector/Magistrate by Central Government to remove such encroachment. Assistance in containing and removing encroachments is also sought from the respective State Government/Police Authorities from time to time. Further, in addition to the regular watch and ward staff, private security personnel have also been deployed for the safety and security of selected monuments/sites. Besides, regular inspections are carried out to assess conservation requirement and measures are taken accordingly.
