GREENFIELD HIGHWAY FROM MALLAPALLE TO KAVULAKUNTLA

192. SHRI YERRAM VENKATA SUBBA REDDY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether six lane access controlled Greenfield Highway from Mallapalle to Kavulakuntla of about 20 kms in Prakasam district of Andhra Pradesh with an estimated cost of ₹ 910 crores was approved in February, 2023;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the work has started, and if so, the estimated time by when the work is going to be completed?

(a) to (c) The project "Six Lane Access Controlled Greenfield Highway from Mallapalle to Kavulakuntla" of length 20 km has been approved on 27.03.2023 with total capital cost of Rs. 909.02 crore.

This project is a part of Bengaluru-Kadapa-Vijayawada Economic Corridor and the agreement for the project was signed on 04.05.2023. The work commenced on 12.02.2024 with scheduled completion date as 10.02.2026.
