**PROGRESS IN URBAN RESILIENCE AND WATER MANAGEMENT UNDER AMRUT 2.0**

**\*231. SMT. MAYA NAROLIYA:**

**Will the Minister of Housing and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:**

- (a) the progress made so far in enhancing urban water security through improvements in water supply, sewerage and septage management in all statutory towns under AMRUT 2.0; and
- (b) the number of cities that have achieved the target of providing water connection to every house and expanding sewerage coverage under this scheme?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PART (a) AND (b) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 231 DUE FOR ANSWER IN THE RAJYA SABHA ON 11.08.2025 REGARDING “PROGRESS IN URBAN RESILIENCE AND WATER MANAGEMENT UNDER AMRUT 2.0”.**

(a) Water and Sanitation are State subjects. Government of India supplements the efforts of the States through schematic interventions/ advisories. It provides financial and technical support to the States.

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0 scheme has been launched on 01 October, 2021 in all Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ cities. States/ Union Territories (UTs) are empowered to select, appraise, prioritise and implement the projects within the broad framework of Mission guidelines. AMRUT mission was subsumed under AMRUT 2.0.

Under AMRUT 2.0, a total of 8,873 projects worth ₹1,94,172.99 crore in 3,358 ULBs/ cities have been approved by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) so far. These includes 3,571 Water supply projects worth ₹1,18,421.92 crore, 586 Sewerage & Septage Management projects worth ₹68,461.78 crore, 3,032 water body rejuvenation projects worth ₹6,210.66 crore and 1,684 green spaces and parks projects worth ₹1,078.63 crore.

As reported by the States/UTs on AMRUT 2.0 portal, contracts have been awarded for 2,585 water supply projects worth ₹70,368.75 crore of which works worth ₹27,983.06 crore have been physically completed. Under the sewerage/septage management sector, contracts have been awarded for 383 projects worth ₹33,734.06 crore of which works worth ₹11,606.19 crore have been physically completed as on 14.07.2025.

(b) As reported by the States/ UTs (as on 14.07.2025), under AMRUT/ AMRUT 2.0 and in convergence with other schemes, 213 lakh water connections and 151 lakh sewer connections have been provided so far. As informed by the States/ UTs, 641 Urban Local Bodies (ULBs)/ Cities have achieved more than 90% coverage of households with piped water supply, as per estimated 2021 population. Under AMRUT, sewerage connections have been expanded in 320 ULBs/ Cities. State wise details are given in Annexure.
