- (a) the actual amount of funds received by the States under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) during the last three years;
- (b) the details of year-wise and State-wise allocation and release of funds; and
- (c) whether there is any shortfall between the sanctioned amount and the amount actually released, and if so, the reasons therefor?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO RAJYA SABHA STARRED OUESTION NO. 23 FOR 22ND JULY, 2025

(a) to (c): The Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) aims to correct regional imbalances in the availability of affordable/reliable tertiary healthcare services and also to augment facilities for quality medical education in the country. The scheme has two components, (i) setting up of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) and (ii) upgradation of existing Government Medical Colleges (GMCs)/institutions. Till date establishment of 22 new AIIMSs and upgradation of 75 GMCs has been approved under the scheme.

PMSSY is a Central Sector Scheme under which Government of India incurs 100% expenditure towards establishment and operation of new AIIMSs. The cost of upgradation of GMCs is shared by the Centre and the respective State Governments. Funds are released as Grants in Aid to the new AIIMS for their functioning and to the Executing Agencies for the project works. Under the PMSSY scheme, no funds are released to the State Governments.

There is adequate availability of funds under the PMSSY scheme. Budget allocated and expenditure incurred during the last three financial years under the scheme is as below:
