- (a) whether India has signed any MoUs in the year 2024-25 for promoting traditional system of medicine;
- (b) if so, the names of such countries and the areas of collaboration identified; and
- (c) the proposed mechanisms for capacity building and knowledge exchange?

(a) to (c) A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

The Statement referred in reply to Rajya Sabha Starred Question No. 278 for 19.08,2025

- (a) to (c) The MoUs signed by Ministry of Ayush, Govt. of India during 2024-25 with foreign countries for promoting traditional systems of medicine is enclosed at Annexure-1. The areas of collaborations as per these MoUs are:
 - i. Promotion including the regulation of teaching, practice, drugs and drugless therapies within the scope of this Memorandum of Understanding.
 - ii. Disseminating authentic information about the medicine/product to the public in the respective countries to promote safe use of the medicine of Ayurveda and other Systems of medicine.
 - iii. Identifying and incorporating new technologies without compromising holistic approach of the different systems of traditional medicine.
 - iv. Exchanging experts for training of Ayurveda & other recognised Traditional Medicines to practitioners, paramedics, scientists, teaching professionals Regulators, Policy Makers students & other interested persons.
 - v. Accommodating interested scientists, practitioners, paramedics and students in institutions for research, educational and training programmes.
 - vi. Mutual recognition of pharmacopoeias and formularies of Ayurveda & other Traditional Medicine Systems.
 - vii. Mutual recognition of Ayurveda and other recognised Traditional System of Medicine in both the countries.
 - viii. Mutual recognition of educational qualifications in Ayurveda & Traditional Medicine awarded by Central / State recognised Universities of respective countries.
 - ix. Setting up of Academic Chairs.
 - x. To promote trade & commerce in the field of Ayurveda & Traditional systems of Medicine & their Medicinal Products.
 - xi. To explore the possibilities to encourage bilateral participation in trade fairs and exhibitions concerning Ayurveda and other recognised Traditional Systems of Medicine.
 - xii. To identify barriers for trade in the countries and to make recommendations on the ways to remove such barriers while safeguarding the public health etc.
 - xiii. Recognition of Ayurveda and Traditional Medicinal preparations on reciprocatory basis as per the existing laws of respective countries.
 - xiv. Permission to practice on reciprocatory basis by the qualified practitioners as per the existing laws.
