**CAMPAIGN UNDER “VIKSIT KRISHI SANKALP ABHIYAN, 2025” IN
UTTARAKHAND**

*68. DR. KALPANA SAINI:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the districts of Uttarakhand where campaign was launched under the “Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan, 2025” and the number of farmers who participated in it, the details thereof;
- (b) whether schemes like Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) and Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) were given special priority under the said campaign in the State; and
- (c) the advanced agricultural techniques and organic/natural farming methods in which the farmers of Uttarakhand were provided training under the said campaign, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (A) TO (C) IN RESPECT OF RAJYA SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 68 FOR REPLY ON 25.07.2025 REGARDING CAMPAIGN UNDER “VIKSIT KRISHI SANKALP ABHIYAN, 2025” IN UTTARAKHAND ASKED BY DR. KALPANA SAINI.

(a): The Viksit Krishi Sankalp Abhiyan was organized during 29 May-12 June 2025 across the country as pre-Kharif campaign with the objectives to create awareness regarding improved agricultural technologies of Kharif season and about various schemes and policies of government on agricultural development among the farmers and also to document farmer-led innovations and feedback of farmers. The campaign was organized in all the 13 districts of Uttarakhand, in which a total of 143972 farmers participated. District wise details of the abhiyan is given in **Annexure-I**.

(b): Yes, awareness was created about improved agricultural technologies for Kharif season, various challenges of the modern agriculture system, promotion of use of advance machines, tools and gadgets and quality inputs (fertilizers, pesticides, seed, etc.) among the farmers. Besides, the farmers were made aware on priority about schemes and policies of government on agricultural development including Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN), Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM) and Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).

(c): The farmers of Uttarakhand were made aware about improved agricultural technologies of Kharif season including practices and methods of organic/natural farming.
