Will the Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution be pleased to state:

- (a): whether Government has assessed the damage to foodgrains in the stock of the Food Corporation of India (FCI) in last five years;
- (b): if so, the details thereof, year-wise, item-wise, State-wise and FCI godown-wise for Punjab, including the monetary value of the damage; and
- (c): the details of foodgrain damage due to insufficient FCI godowns, and the steps taken by Government to prevent such foodgrain damage in future?
