- (a) the details of the youth shortlisted under the Pradhan Mantri Internship Scheme, Statewise;
- (b) the details of the monthly salary received by the candidates selected under this scheme
- by Central Government; and
- (c) the areas of internship for youth targeted to be included under the PM Internship Scheme?

#### **ANSWER**

(a): The Prime Minister Internship Scheme (PMIS) was announced in the Budget 2024-25. It aims to provide internship opportunities to one crore youth in top 500 companies in five years. As an initiation to this scheme, Ministry of Corporate Affairs has launched a Pilot Project of the scheme on 3rd October, 2024, which is targeted to provide 1.25 lakh internship opportunities to the youth in one year.

In the round I of the PM Internship Scheme Pilot Project, the partner companies posted more than 1.27 lakh internship opportunities on the PMIS Portal across the country. Against this, more than 6.21 lakh applications were received from about 1.81 lakh candidates. Over 3.23 lakh applications were shortlisted and sent to the companies for further selection.

In the round II of the PM Internship Scheme Pilot Project, which commenced on 9th January, 2025, about 327 Partner Companies have posted over 1.18 lakh internship opportunities (new and edited unfilled opportunities of previous round) across 735 districts of the country. Over 4.55 lakh applications were received from over 2.14 lakh applicants, in this round. In this round, over 3.05 lakh applications were shortlisted and sent to the companies for further selection. Currently, rolling out of offers and the process of acceptances/joining by interns is in progress.

State-wise details of the applications shortlisted under the Round I and Round II of the Pilot Project is attached at Annexure.

- (b): Under the Pilot Project, a one-time grant for incidentals of ₹6,000 is disbursed to each intern by the government upon the intern's joining at the internship location, subject to verification by the company. In addition, every month the company, based upon the intern's attendance and related company policies, releases Rs.500/- to each intern from its CSR funds. Once the company makes the payment, the government releases Rs.4,500 per month to intern through Direct Benefit Transfer to their Aadhaar seeded bank account.
- (c): The partner companies are providing internship opportunities in large number of diverse sectors like Aviation and Defence, Automotive, Banking and Financial Services, Chemical Industry, Oil, Gas and Energy, Food processing and roles in different areas such as sales, accounting, supply chain management, process associate, manufacturing associate and plant operation etc.

The PM Internship Scheme Portal (Portal) is accessible in 12 different languages, to enhance inclusivity from different geographical regions of the country. Further, the Ministry of Corporate Affairs is actively working with various stakeholders such as state governments, industry associations, educational institutions etc. for promotion and implementation of the scheme. The Ministry is also carrying out Information, Education and Communication activities to reach out to the target groups across the country.
