STATUS OF PM-ABHIM IN UTTAR PRADESH

1086. DR. LAXMIKANT BAJPAYEE:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- a) the impact of various measures taken under Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Mission (PM-ABHIM) in Uttar Pradesh;
- b) the health infrastructure developed/being developed in Uttar Pradesh under PM-ABHIM in the last five years, the details thereof, sector-wise and district-wise; and
- c) the amount sanctioned and released to Uttar Pradesh under this scheme during the last five years, the details thereof, year-wise?

(a) to (c): Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission (PM-ABHIM) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) with select Central Sector Components (CSC), having a total outlay of ₹64,180 Crores for the period 2021-22 to 2025-26.

The scheme envisions a new generation of reforms to integrate and strengthen health service delivery and public health action, including health research, with the goal of making communities Atmanirbhar (self-reliant) in managing pandemics or health crises. The interventions aim to enhance the capacity of health systems and institutions to provide a continuum of care across primary, secondary, and tertiary levels, while also equipping them to respond effectively to current and future pandemics and disasters.

Under the CSS component of PM-ABHIM, provisions have been made for the State of Uttar Pradesh for the construction and strengthening of 1,670 building-less Ayushman Arogya Mandir-Sub Health Centre (SHC-AAM), 674 Urban- Ayushman Arogya Mandirs (U-AAM), 515 Block Public Health Units (BPHUs), 75 Integrated Public Health Labs (IPHLs), and 74 Critical Care Blocks (CCBs) during the scheme period from FY 2021-22 to 2025-26 with the total financial outlay of **Rs. 5,084.07 Crores**.

Administrative approvals have been accorded to the State of Uttar Pradesh for five years (i.e. FY 2021-22 to 2025-26) for an amount of Rs. 5249.99 Cr. for following measures:

- Support provided for construction/strengthening of 1,670 building-less SHC-AAMs and 674 Urban –AAM in Uttar Pradesh has significantly improved the access of quality primary healthcare in rural and urban areas, especially in underserved areas. This has enabled timely delivery of essential services and reduction of out-of-pocket expenditure.
- Strengthening block-level primary and secondary healthcare services through the establishment of 75 Integrated Public Health Laboratories (IPHLs) and 515 Block Public Health Units (BPHUs) has led to a significant increase in diagnostic testing and enhanced disease surveillance capabilities for better monitoring of disease pattern.
- The establishment of 74 Critical Care Blocks (CCBs) has augmented the capacity of public health facilities to provide timely and specialized critical care services during the pandemics.

The district wise approvals under PM-ABHIM in the State of Uttar Pradesh is at **Annexure-I**.
