Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of SC-ST beneficiaries assisted under the National SC-ST Hub (NSSH) scheme till June, 2025, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total number of SC/ST candidates trained in entrepreneurship and skill development under the scheme, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether Government has undertaken any initiatives to create awareness and outreach among SC/ST-entrepreneurs regarding the benefits of the scheme, and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the total budgetary allocation, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) whether Government has assessed the impact of the NSSH-scheme on improving the market linkages, credit access, and ease of doing business for SC/ST-entrepreneurs, and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SUSHRI SHOBHA KARANDLAJE)

- (a): Under the National Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe Hub (NSSH) Scheme, 1,45,200 SC/ST beneficiaries have been assisted across the country till June 2025. The State/UT-wise number of SC/ST beneficiaries under NSSH Scheme is enclosed at *Annexure-I*.
- (b): Under the capacity building programme of NSSH Scheme, 44097 SC/ST candidates have been trained till June 2025. The State/UT-wise number of SC/ST candidates trained under NSSH Scheme is enclosed at *Annexure-II*.
- (c): To spread awareness about the various initiatives under NSSH Scheme, Mega Event/conclave, Special Vendor Development Programme and awareness programmes are being organized at various locations in the country. Under NSSH scheme, 758 Special Vendor Development Programme, 700 Awareness Campaigns and 59 Mega Events/conclave have been conducted.

(d): The total plan outlay under NSSH Scheme in 15th Financial Cycle i.e. from FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26 is Rs. 588 crore. Funds are not allocated State/UT-wise as it is a Central Sector Schemes. Funds allocated and released to the implementing agency i.e, National Small Industries Corporation Limited (NSIC), a CPSE under this Ministry during last four years are as under:

(e): For continuation of NSSH Scheme in 15th Financial Cycle i.e. from FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26, an evaluation study was conducted in the year 2020 to understand the impact of the scheme. The study recommended for its continuation with enhanced tenure to cover the complete entrepreneur development and enhanced life cycle. The report also highlights areas of focus to expand the reach of the scheme such as inclusion of service sector under Special Credit Linked Capital Subsidy Scheme (SCLCSS), medium-term social media strategy for effective outreach, constitution of a NSSHO level cell to assist SCST enterprises in the transactional issues of government tenders, assistance for participation in virtual exhibitions, etc.
