1299 # SHRI RAJENDRA GEHLOT:

Will the Minister of Communications be pleased to state:

- (a) the total length of optical fibre cables laid across the country during last three years, State-wise and district-wise specially with respect to Rajasthan;
- (b) the total amount allocated/released and utilized for laying and maintenance of optical fibre cables across the country during last three years, district-wise details thereof specially with respect to Rajasthan; and
- (c) whether Government is planning to run any skill training programme regarding laying and maintenance of optical fibre cables, if so, the details thereof?

- (a) As of March 31, 2025, a total of 6,98,010 route KM of Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) has been laid across the country during the last three years. The state-wise details are attached as **Annexure-I**.
- (b) A sum of Rs. 11,014.35 crores have been allocated/ released and utilized under BharatNet Project including Rs. 605.97 crores for Rajasthan during the last three years (FY 2022-23 to 2024-25).
- (c) Presently, there is no proposal to introduce such training programs.
