Global Climate financing instruments

1347. SMT. SULATA DEO:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry facilitate access to global climate financing instruments (like GCF or Adaptation Fund) for Odisha's State climate action plan (SAPCC) implementation;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI KIRTI VARDHAN SINGH)

(a) to (b) The Government of India has been engaging with the Green Climate Fund (GCF) and the Adaptation Fund for executing mitigation and adaptation activities in the country. So far, thirteen (13) projects/ programmes have been approved to India with a total allocation of US\$ 1.0 billion under GCF to mitigate and adapt to climate change in sectors including water, clean energy, coastal, livelihood, transport, medium and small enterprises and climate startups; and US\$ 16.86 million from the multilateral Adaptation Fund respectively.

The details of the projects which are being implemented in the State of Odisha under the GCF and Adaptation Fund are given at **Annexure**.

Further, the Government of India has supported preparation of State Action Plans on Climate Change (SAPCC) in the States and Union Territories, including the State of Odisha. The details regarding financial assistance for the preparation of the revised SAPCC of Odisha are as follows:
