Will the Minister of **TOURISM** be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of individuals trained under the Capacity Building for Service Providers (CBSP) scheme since its inception;
- (b) the employment rate or entrepreneurial outcomes of individuals trained under these schemes, particularly in the rural tourism sector;
- (c) whether women and youth from backward and tribal areas are getting proper access to these training programme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(a) to (d): Under the Scheme of “Capacity Building for Service Providers” (CBSP), Ministry of Tourism conducts training programmes for the tourism Stakeholders across the Country including urban, rural and tribal areas. The outcome of these trainings includes placements, self employment, in addition to many trainees opting for higher studies such as diploma and degree courses. As per information available, a total of 5.54 lakh persons have been trained since inception and 59210 have been placed.

All the Government and empanelled institutes advertise the training programs through various channels before conducting the training which makes this effective in reaching a diverse group of candidates, including women and youth from tribal areas.
