DETAILS OF AADHAAR CARDS ISSUED

1506. SHRI ABDUL WAHAB:

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Aadhaar cards issued in the country in the last five years, State-wise, year-wise;
- (b) the details of Blue Aadhaar cards issued in the country in the last five years, State-wise, year-wise; and
- (c) the details of people who still do not possess an Aadhaar card in the country, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI JITIN PRASADA)

(a) to (c): Aadhaar is a 12-digit unique identification number issued by the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) to residents (individual who has resided in India for 182 days or more in last 12 months) or a Non-Resident Indian, based on their biometric and demographic data. It serves as a digital identity for accessing different services.

The enrolment for Aadhaar is voluntary and any eligible individual can apply for Aadhaar number from anywhere in the country regardless of the state of his residence. The details of Aadhaar issued is available at www.uidai.gov.in.
