ALLOCATION OF FUNDS UNDER SPMRM IN SIKKIM

- (a) the total funds allocated and released for rural infrastructure projects under the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM) in Sikkim over the last three years;
- (b) the number of rural clusters developed under SPMRM in the State of Sikkim, district-wise:
- (c) whether Government has identified any challenges in the implementation of this scheme, particularly in land slide-affected districts; and
- (d) the steps being taken to expedite rural infrastructure development in disaster-prone areas?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): A total of Rs.14.835cr of funds was released under SPMRM in Sikkim. The year wise details are as given below:

March 31, 2022, has been declared the sunset date for the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM). Further, no funds were allotted under the scheme.

(b) to (d): Three Rural Clusters developed under SPMRM in the state of Sikkim, one each in Pakyong, Namchi and Soreng District. All infrastructure projects have been successfully completed under the Cluster and no infrastructure development project under SPMRM was directly impacted by disaster.
