Will the Minister of Rural Development be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of people who have been benefited from the Prime Minister's GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyan (PMGKRA) in the six States whose districts were included in the said scheme;
- (b) the types of activities prioritized for employment creation under the campaign; and
- (c) whether Government will consider including other States in the said scheme as well, if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(SHRI KAMLESH PASWAN)

(a): The GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyaan (GKRA) was launched on 20th June 2020 for a period of 125 days with resource envelop of Rs. 50,000 crore to boost employment and livelihood opportunities for migrant workers returning to villages and similarly affected citizens in rural areas. A total of 116 districts across six States namely Bihar, Jharkhand, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh were included in the Abhiyaan and a total of 50.78 crorepersondays were generated during the Abhiyaan. State-wise person-days generated under the GaribKalyanRojgarAbhiyaan is given below:

(b): The Abhiyaan adopted a multipronged strategy of providing immediate employment & livelihood opportunities to the distressed, to saturate the villages with public infrastructure and creation of livelihood assets to boost the income generation activities and enhance long term livelihood opportunities by giving focus on 25 works (including works under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme). The details of achievements/works completed under the GKRA are given at **Annexure-II**.

(c): The GKRA ended on 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2020.
